Not so long ago, before she could even speak words, Trixie went on an errand with her daddy....






Trixie and her daddy went down the block,

through the park,




past the school,








Blaggle plabble!


Wamby Flappy?!

Trixie bawled.







She went boneless.

She did everything she could to show how unhappy she was.






By the time they got home, her daddy was unhappy, too.

The whole family ran down the block.


And they ran through the park.




They zoomed past the school,
