This is to be my symphony.

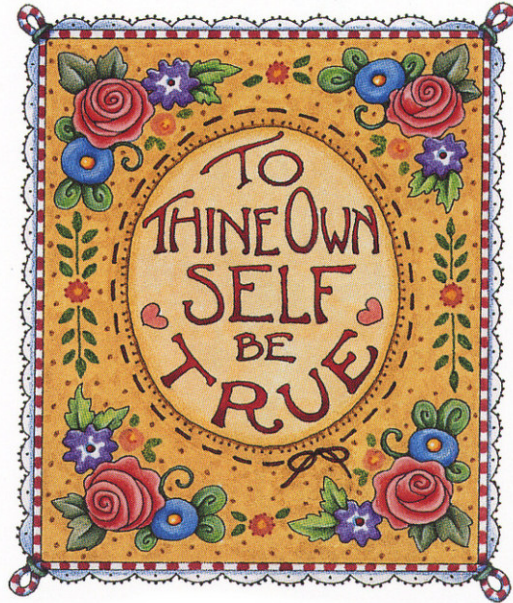
