Before I go to bed I'm going to run around.





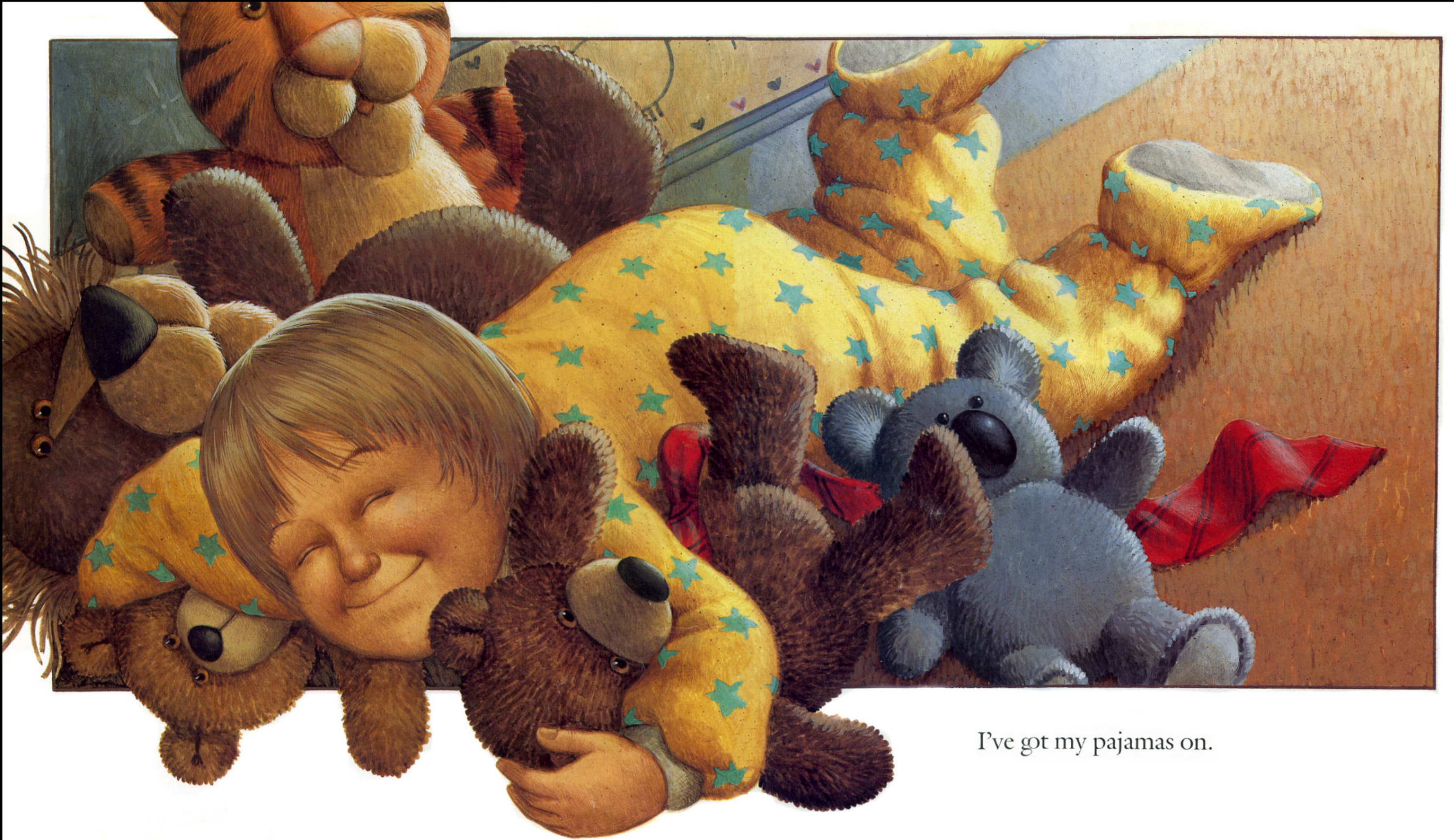
I'm standing on my head
