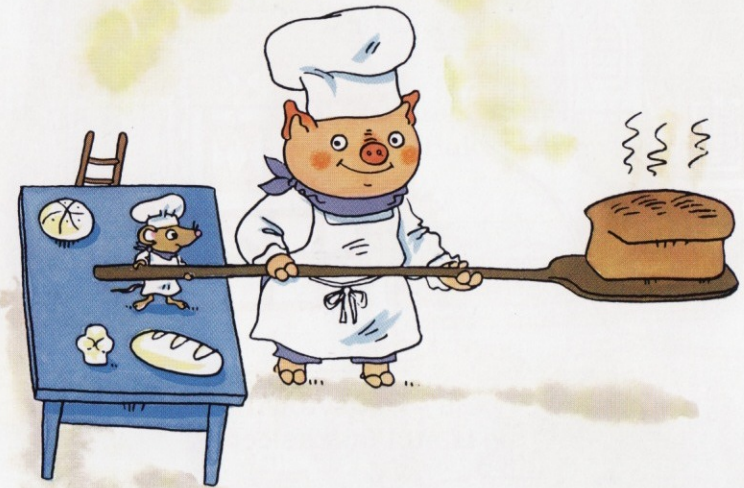

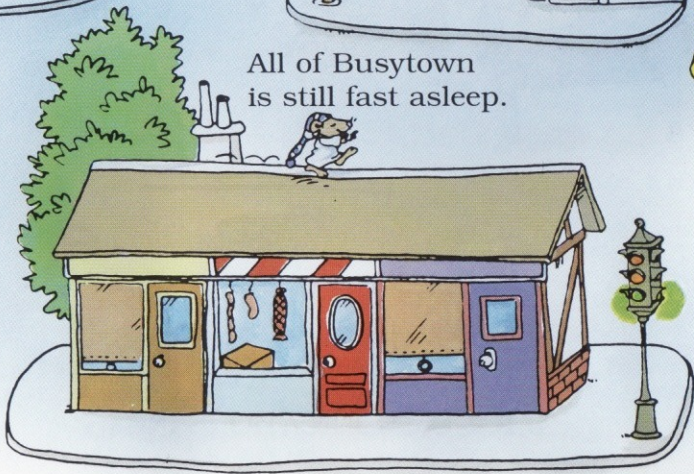
Humperdink's Busy Day



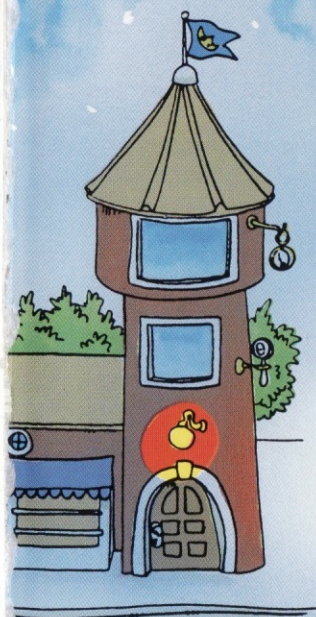

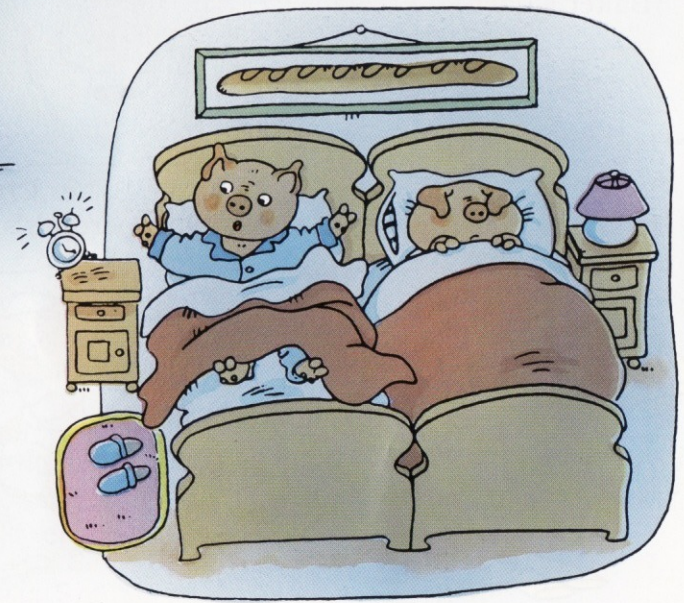
It is very early

next to Baker Humperdink's bed.

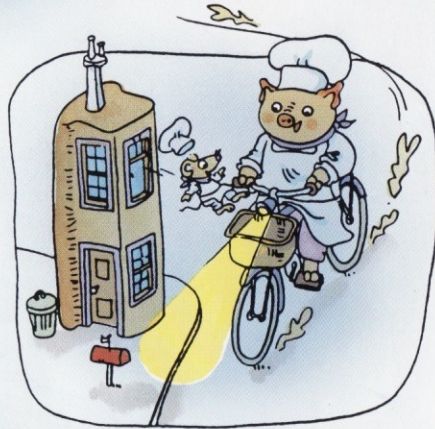


It is time for

Busytowners!

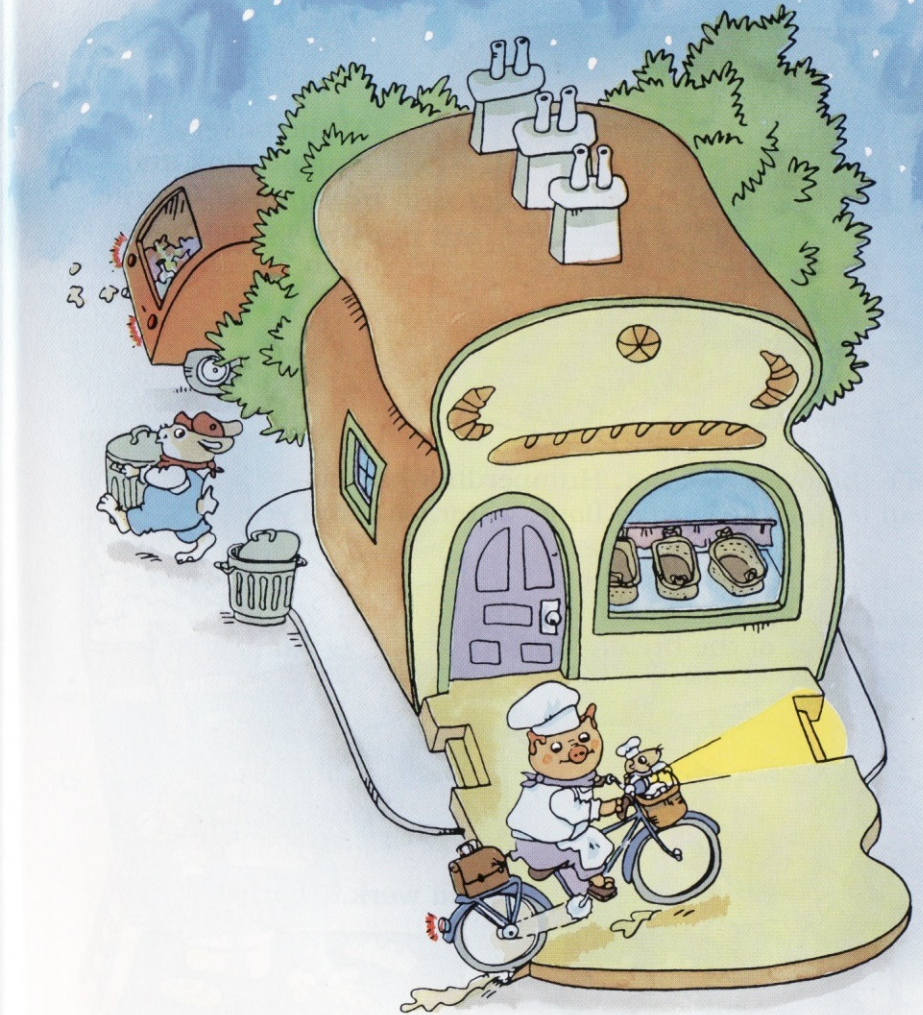
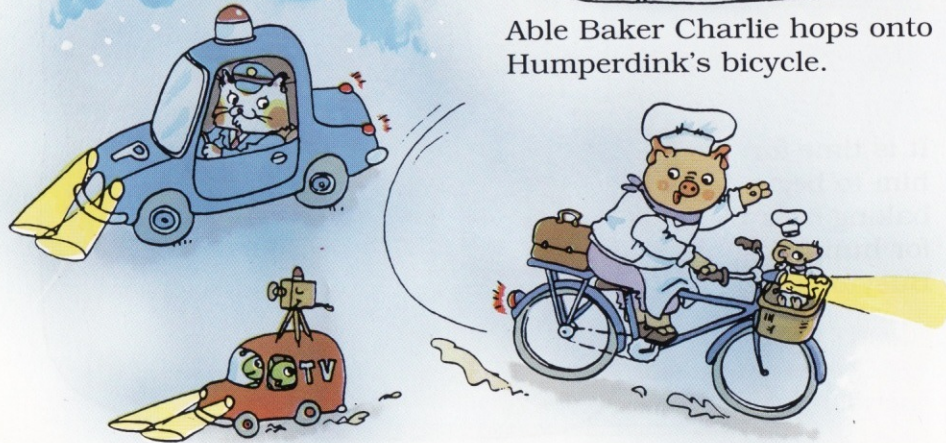


Baker Humperdink rides off through the dark on his bicycle to the bakery.

Able Baker Charlie hops onto Humperdink's bicycle.



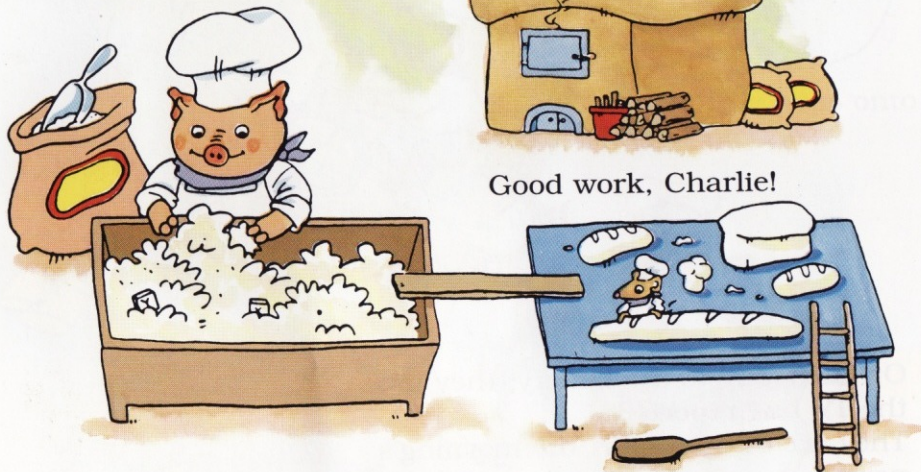
On their way to the bakery, they pass the TV bug reporters. They are out to report the morning's news.

dough.

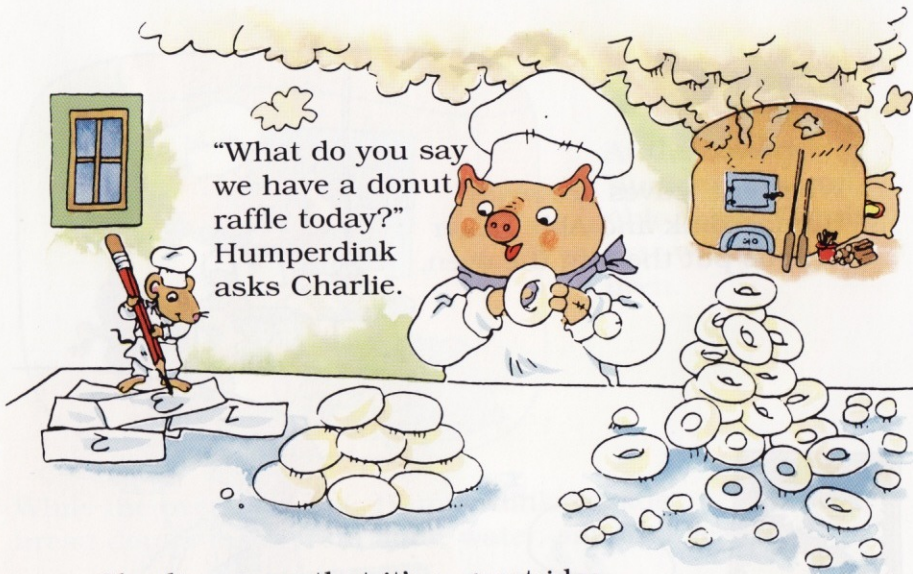


Good work, Charlie!

Charlie put them in the oven.

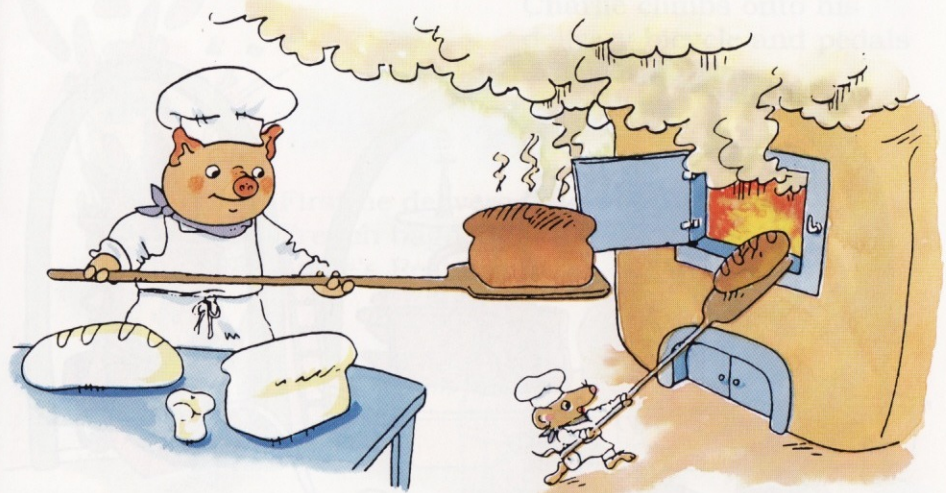


Now they must wait for the loaves
of bread to bake.



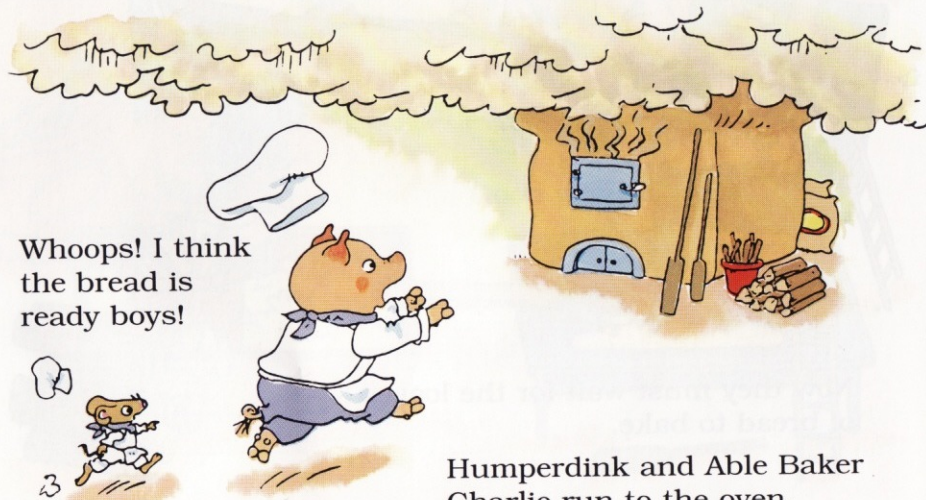
"What do you say we have a donut raffle today?" Humperdink asks Charlie.

Charlie agrees that it's a great idea. He prepares the raffle tickets while Humperdink makes the donuts.



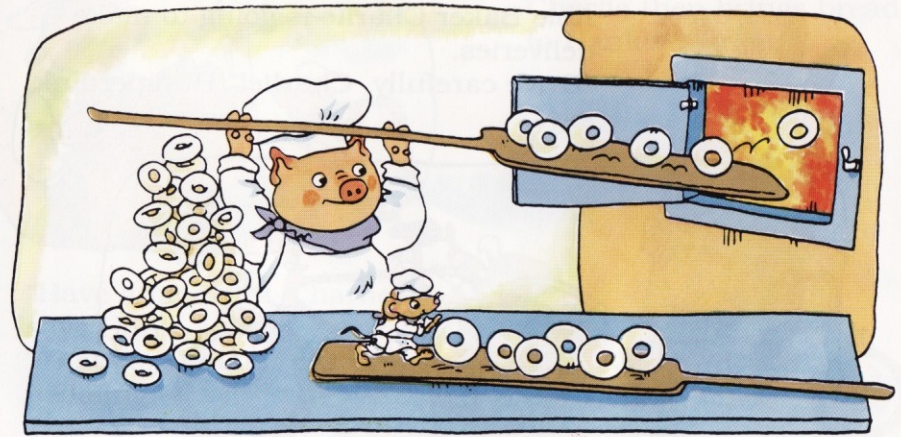
They take out the baked bread just in time. Ummm! Doesn't it smell delicious?

Whoops! I think the bread is ready boys!

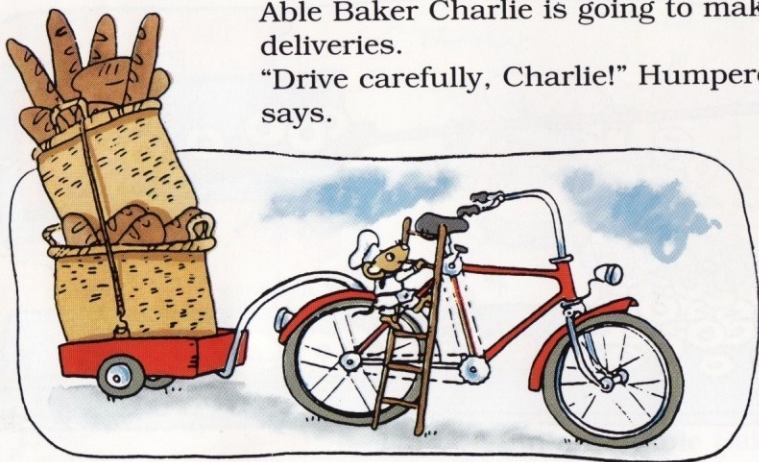
Humperdink and Able Baker Charlie run to the oven.

First he delivers long French baguettes to Louie's Restaurant.

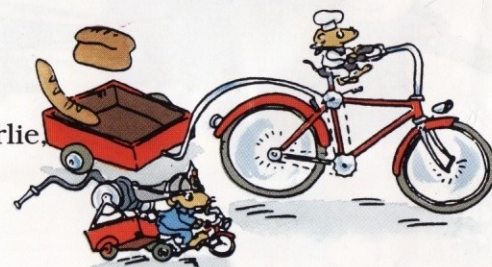
"How are you today?" Louie asks Charlie. "Very well, thank you!" replies Able Baker Charlie.

"Have a nice day, Charlie!" says Hank. "Thanks, Hank!" says Charlie, pedaling away.

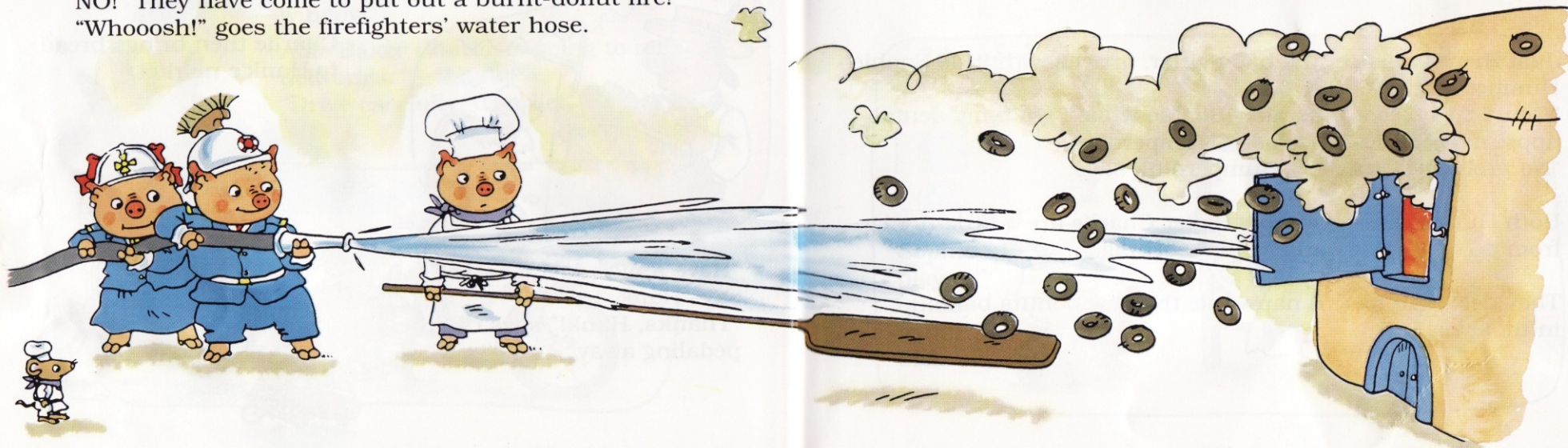


When Able Baker Charlie returns to the bakery,

Oh no! It's the firefighters again!

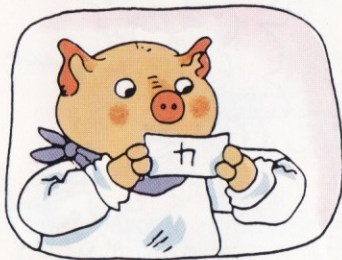
Humperdink and Able Baker

"is number four!"

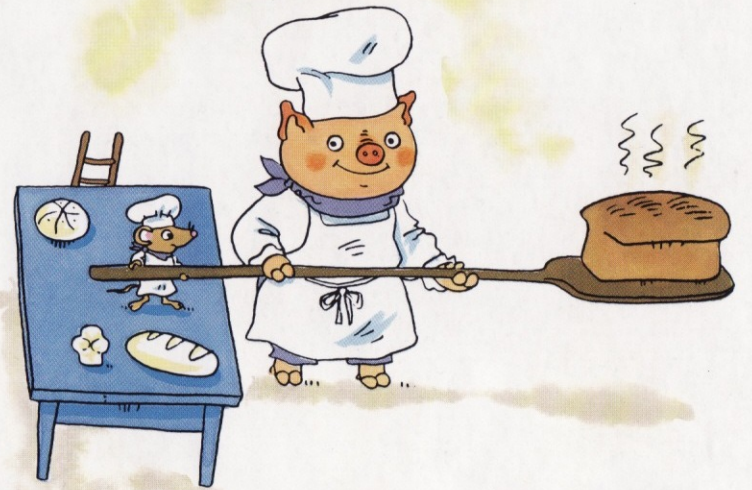
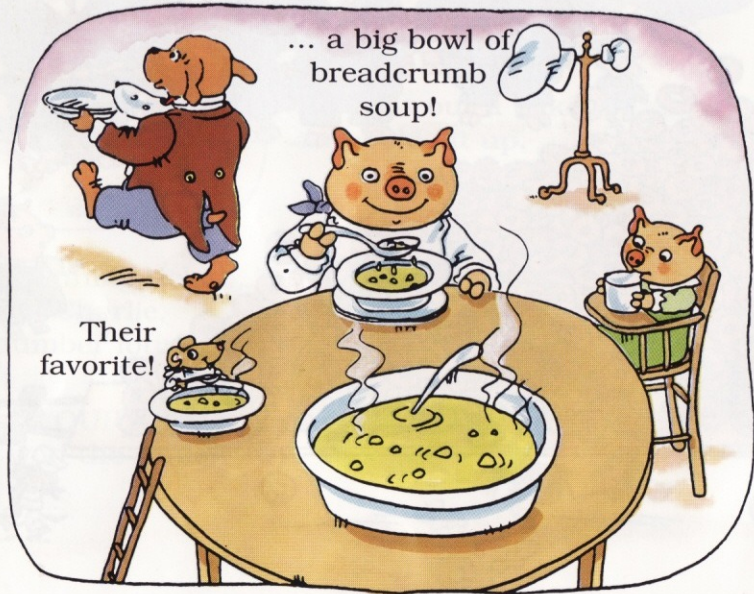
"That's OUR ticket!" says Smokey.
