

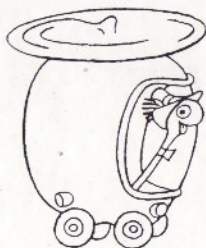

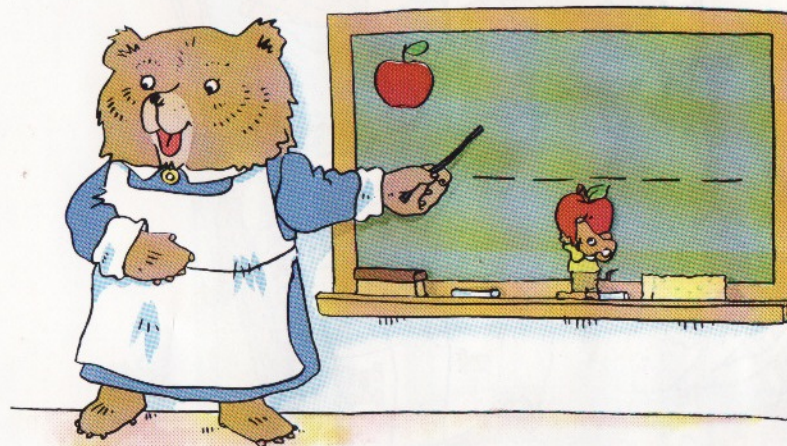

Miss Honey's Busy Day

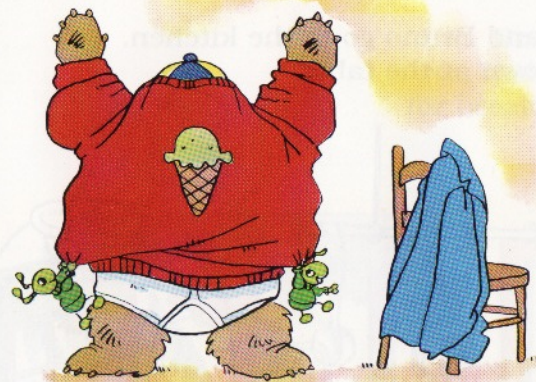

too, Bruno!

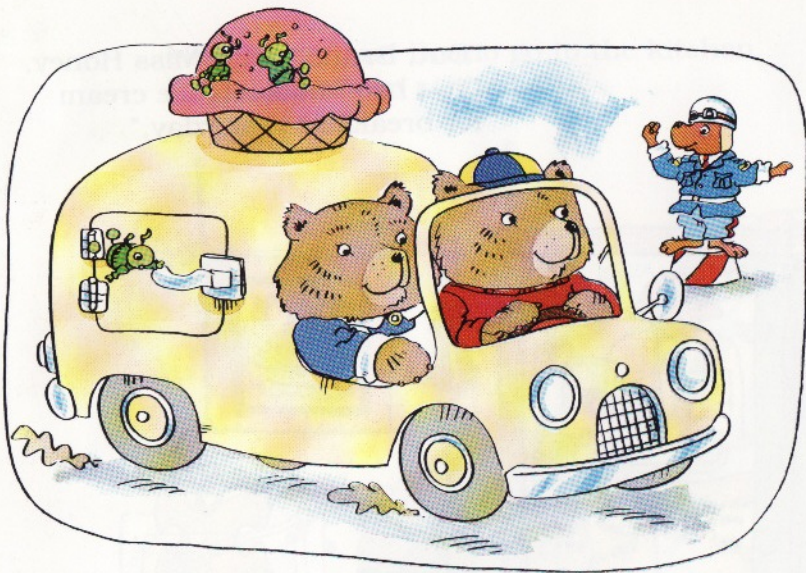
Miss Honey and Bruno go to the kitchen.

The children take their seats in the classroom, and Miss Honey checks the attendance list.

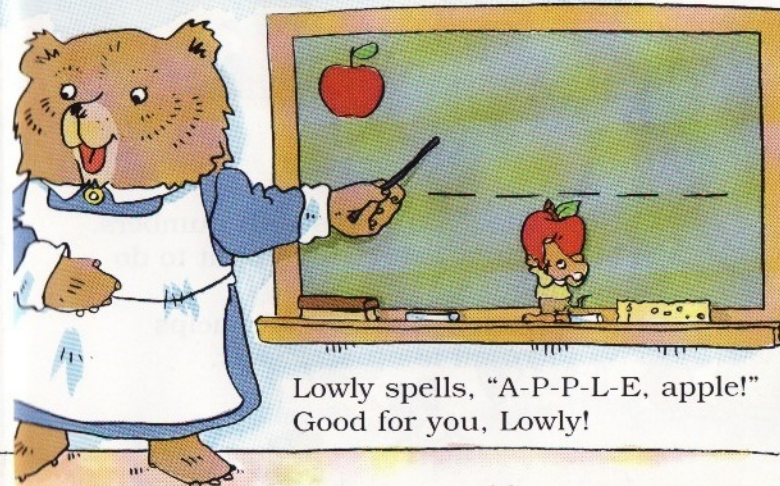


"Hilda? Huckle? Lowly?... Vanderbuilt?" she asks.

"Uncle Gronkle's car wouldn't start this morning!"

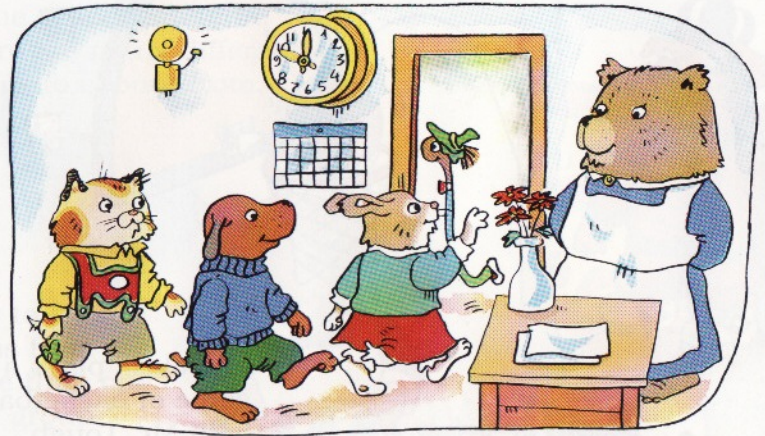


Lowly spells, "A-P-P-L-E, apple!"
Good for you, Lowly!



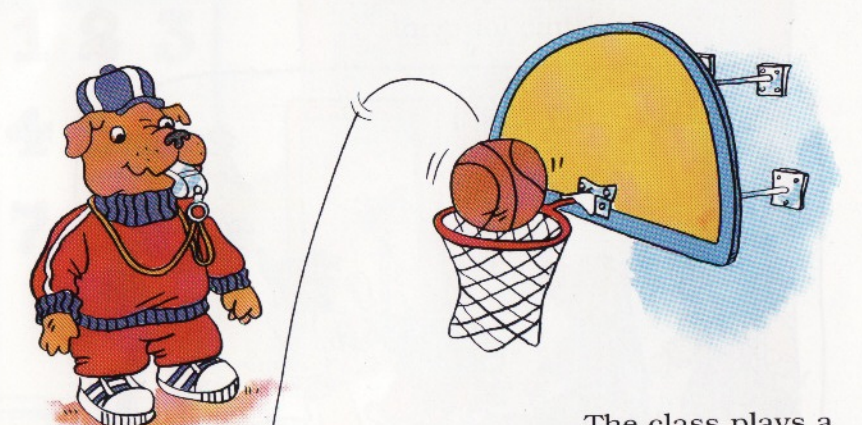
Next, the class works with numbers. Miss Honey asks Vanderbuilt to do an addition. Miss Honey is patient and helps Vanderbuilt find the answer.

It's time for gym!

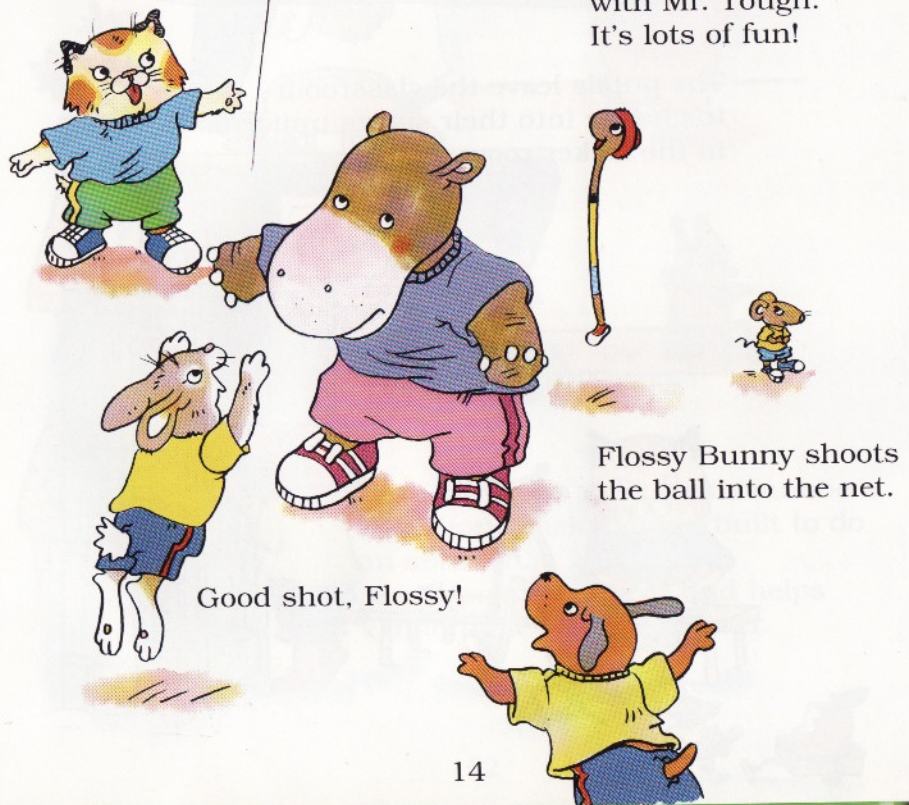


The pupils leave the classroom to change into their sports uniforms in the locker room.





The class plays a game of basketball with Mr. Tough. It's lots of fun!



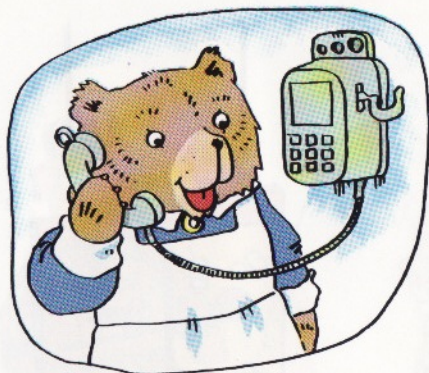
Flossy Bunny shoots the ball into the net.

The class rides to the firehouse in the school bus.



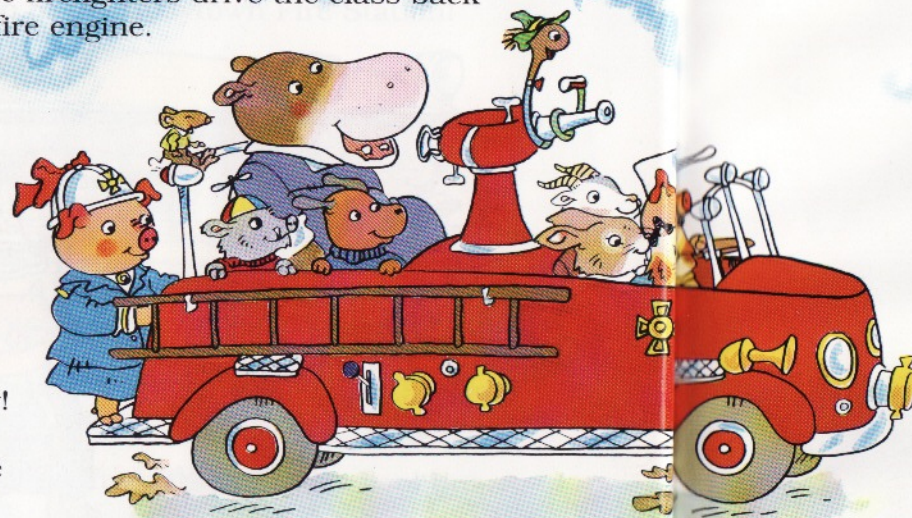
Smokey greets them at the door.

"Wow!" says Huckle. "This is neat!"

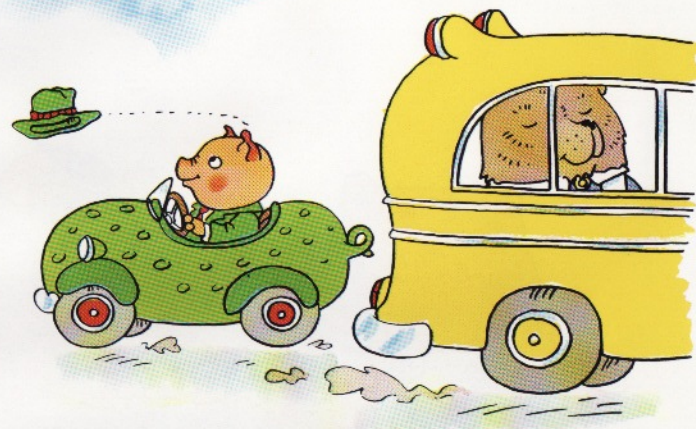


The children learn all about the fire truck and the firefighters' duties, and Snuzzle brings everyone refreshments.

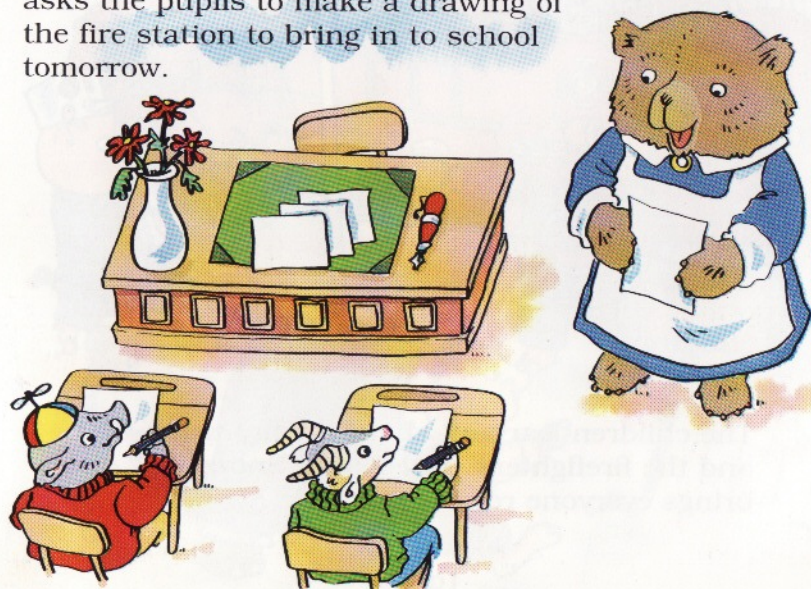
As a surprise, the firefighters drive the class back to school in the fire engine.
