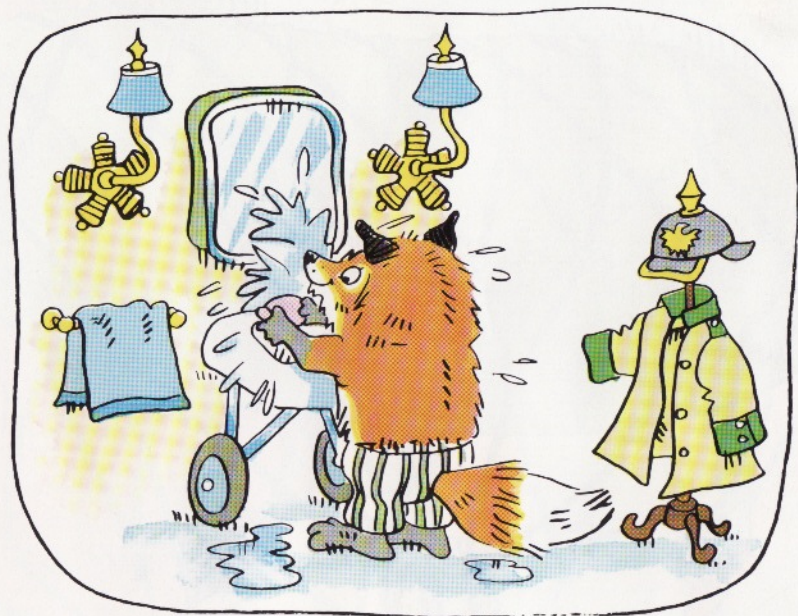

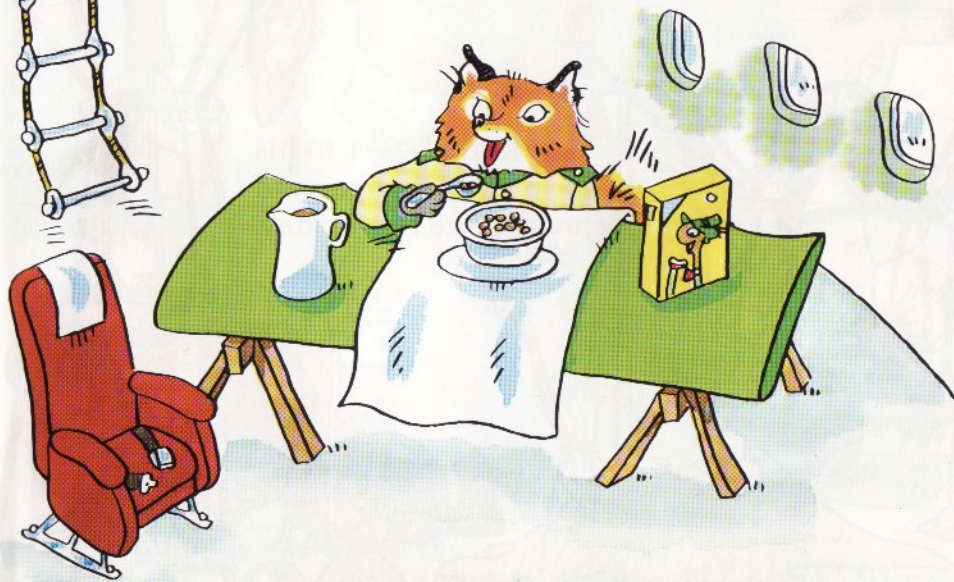
Rudolf Von Flugel's Busy Day

Rudolf says.

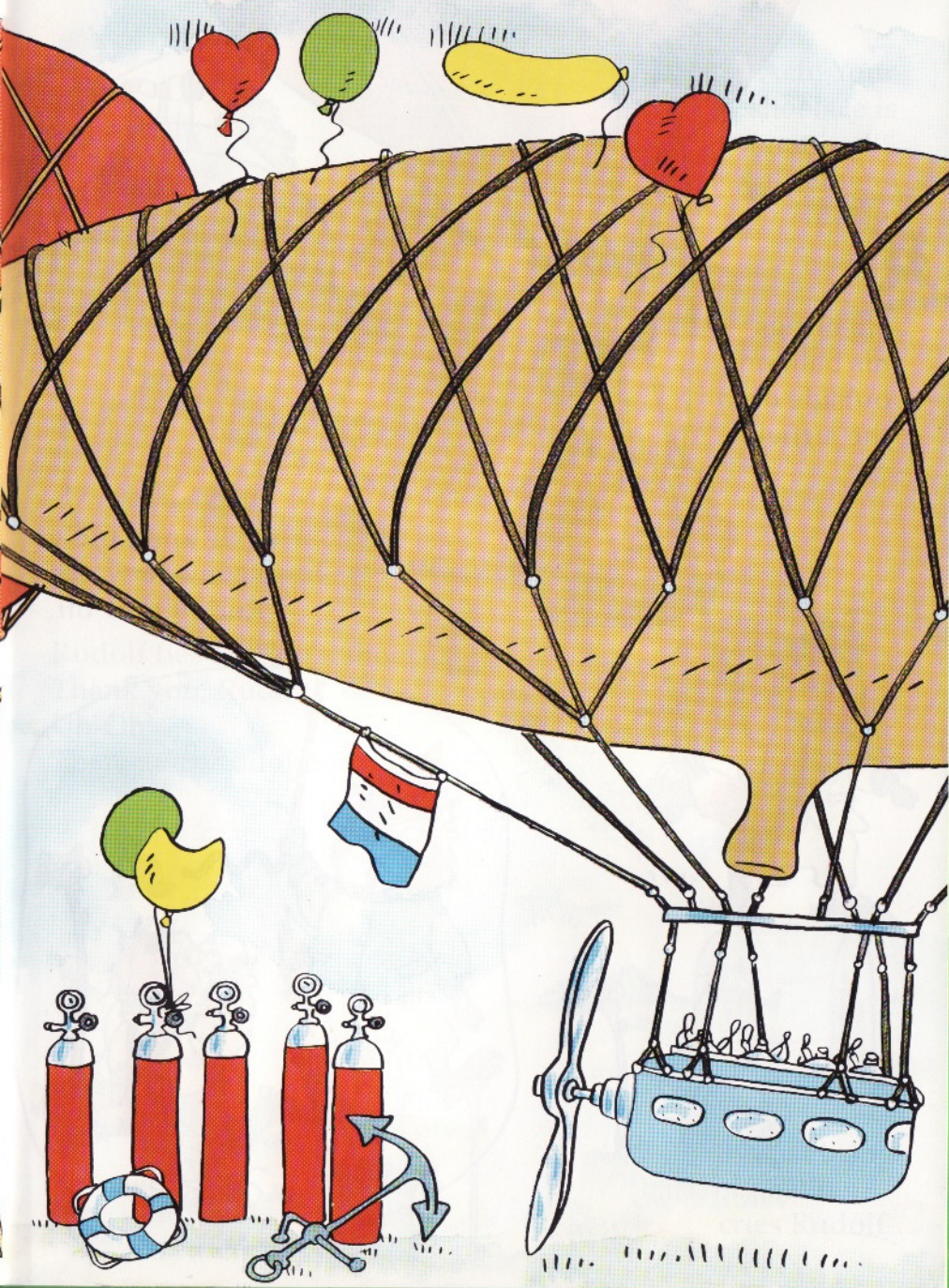


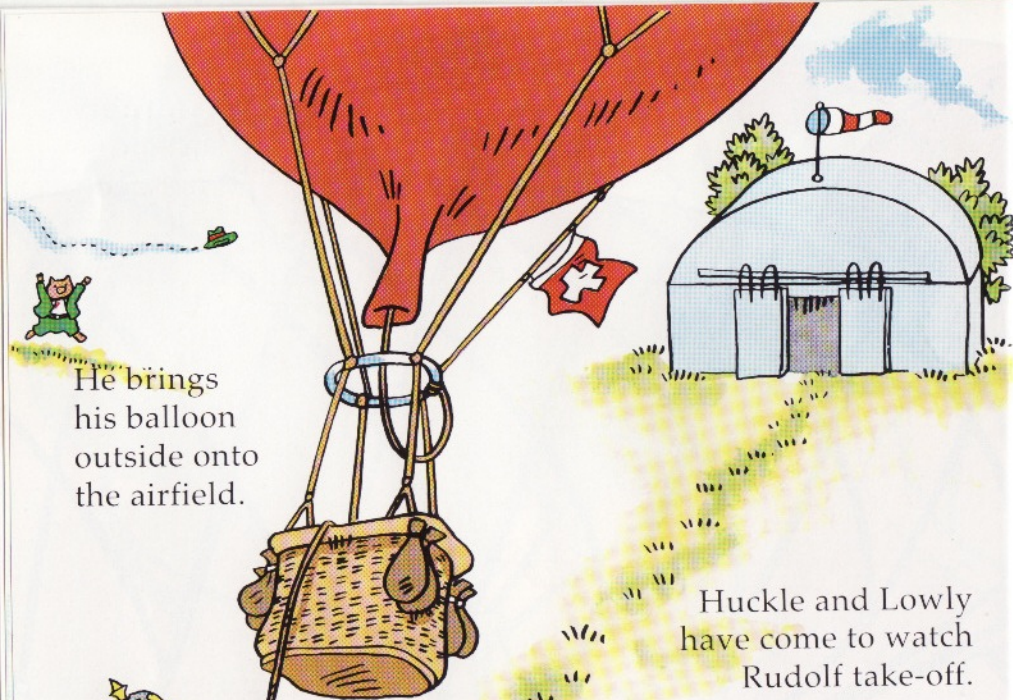
Rudolf washes, dresses, and then has breakfast.

chooses one for the day.





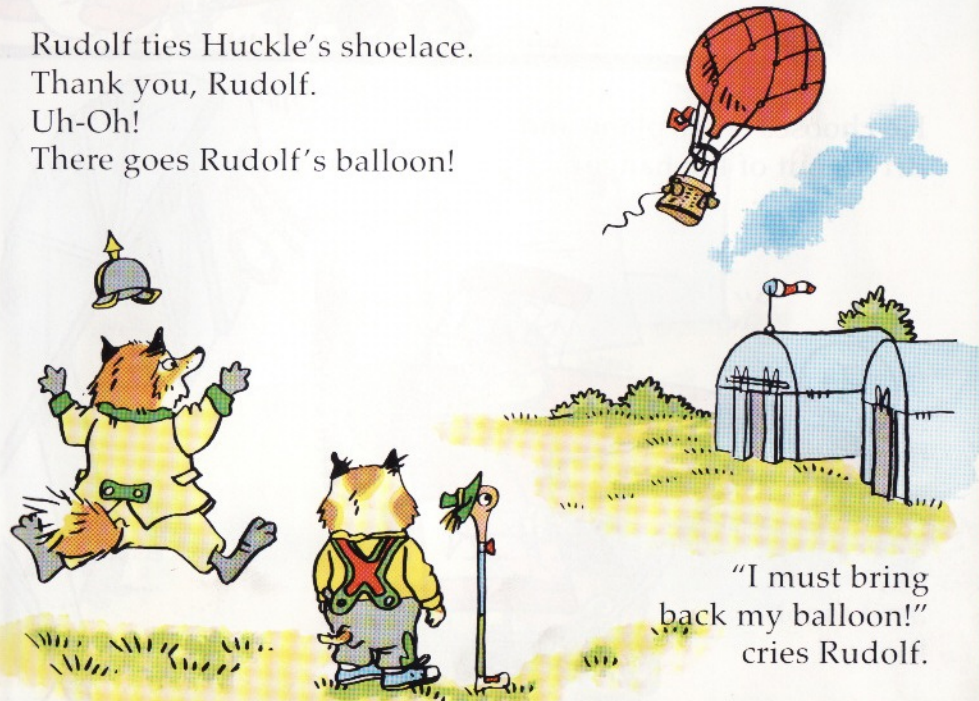
He brings his balloon outside onto the airfield.

Huckle and Lowly have come to watch Rudolf take-off.

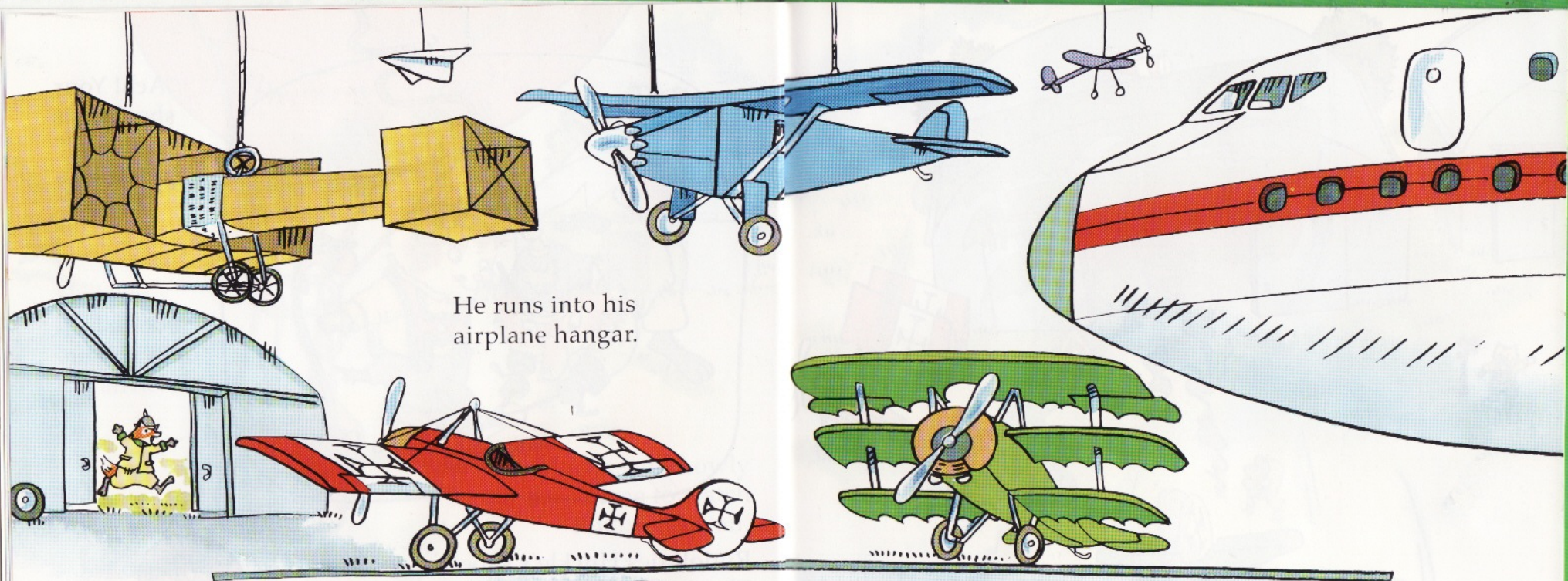


"Ach! Your shoelace is not tied!" Rudolf tells Huckle.

Rudolf ties Huckle's shoelace. Thank you, Rudolf. Uh-Oh! There goes Rudolf's balloon!

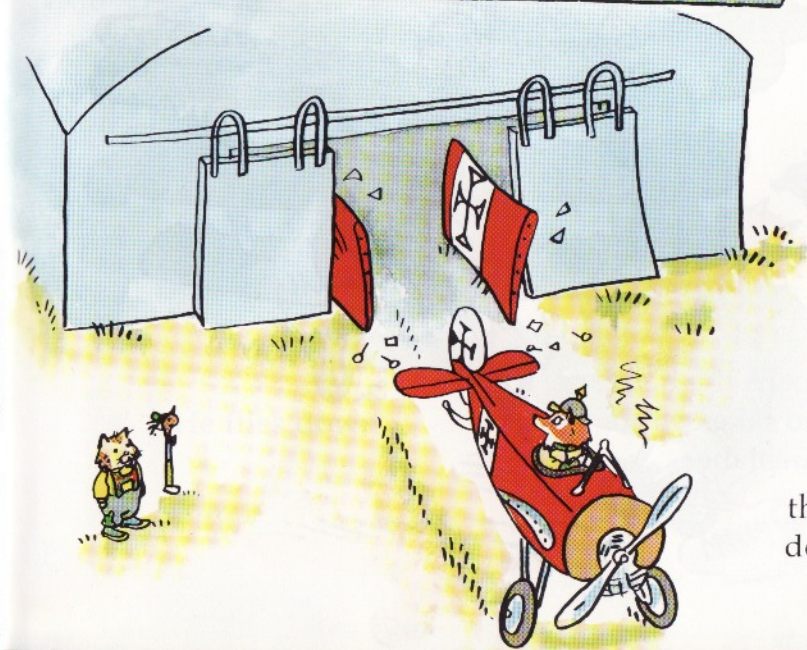
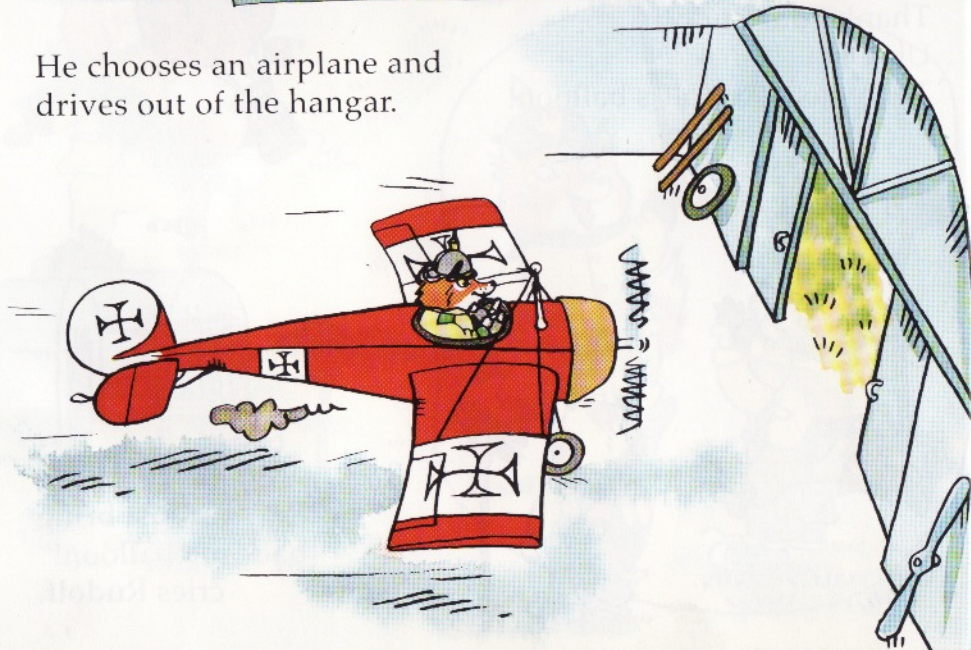


"I must bring back my balloon!" cries Rudolf.

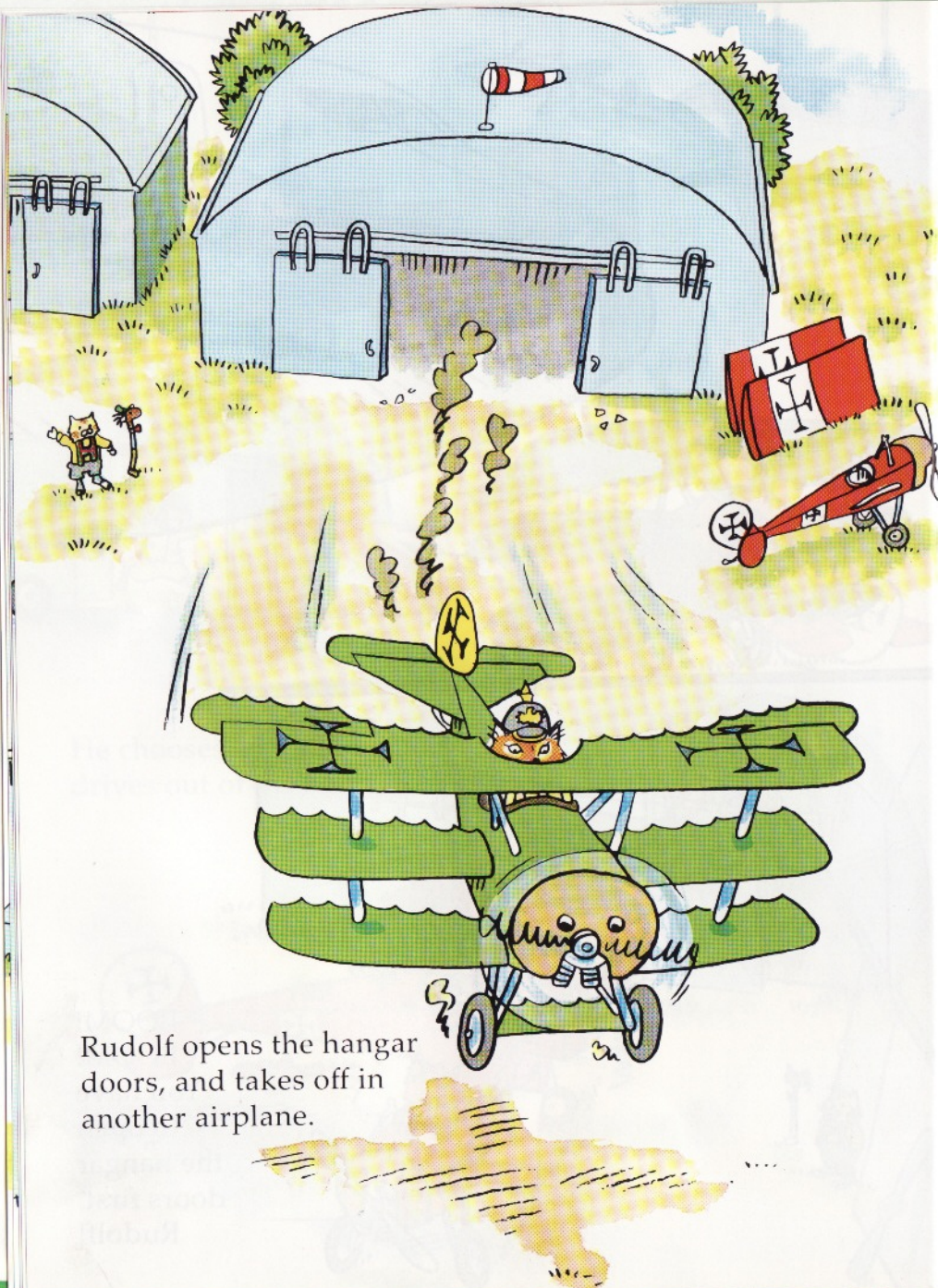


He runs into his airplane hangar.

You have to open the hangar doors first, Rudolf!

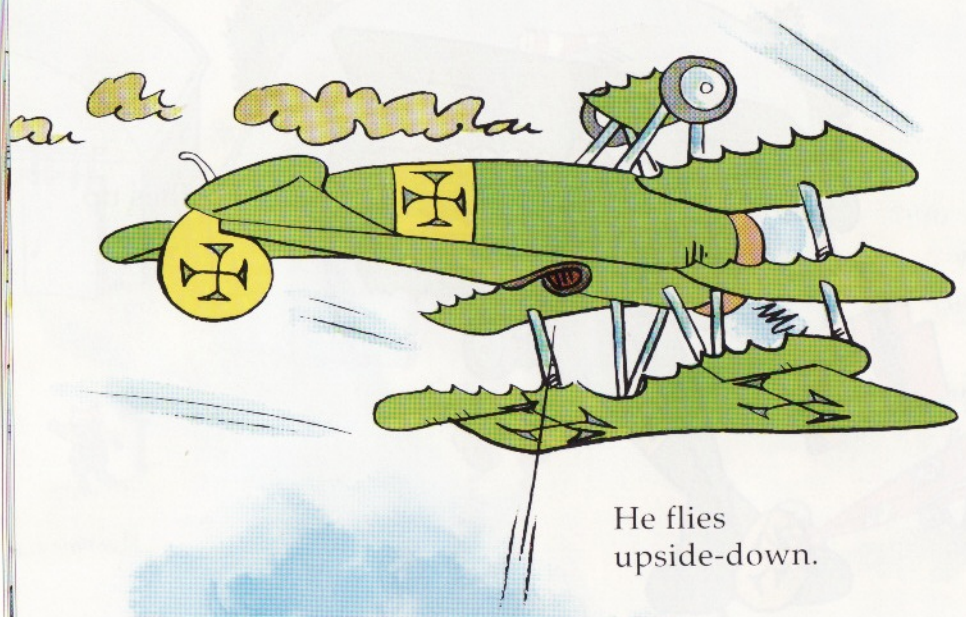


Rudolf opens the hangar doors, and takes off in another airplane.

He flies down.

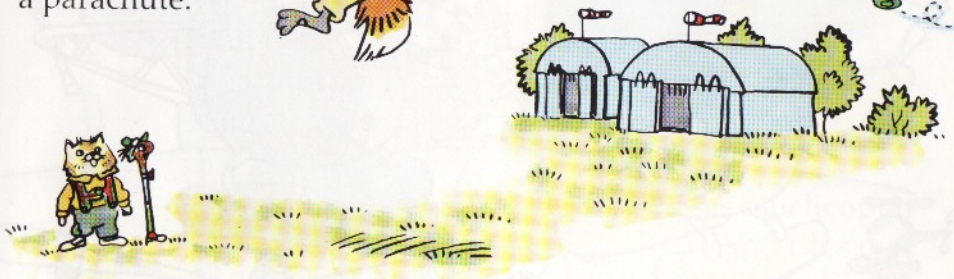


He flies upside-down.

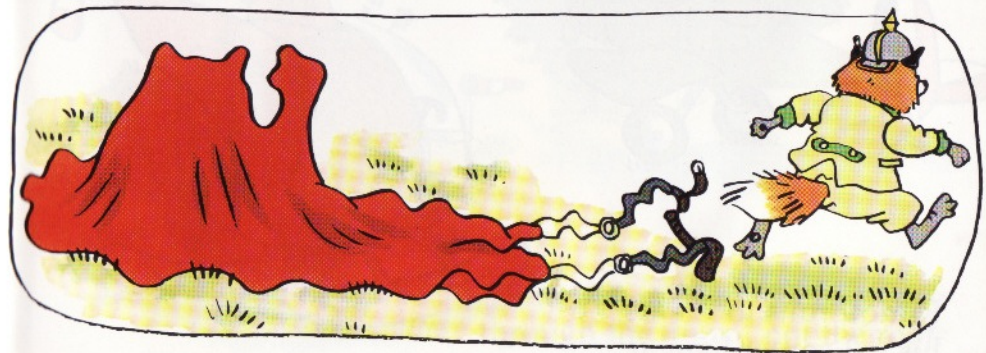
Whoops!

his seatbelt.

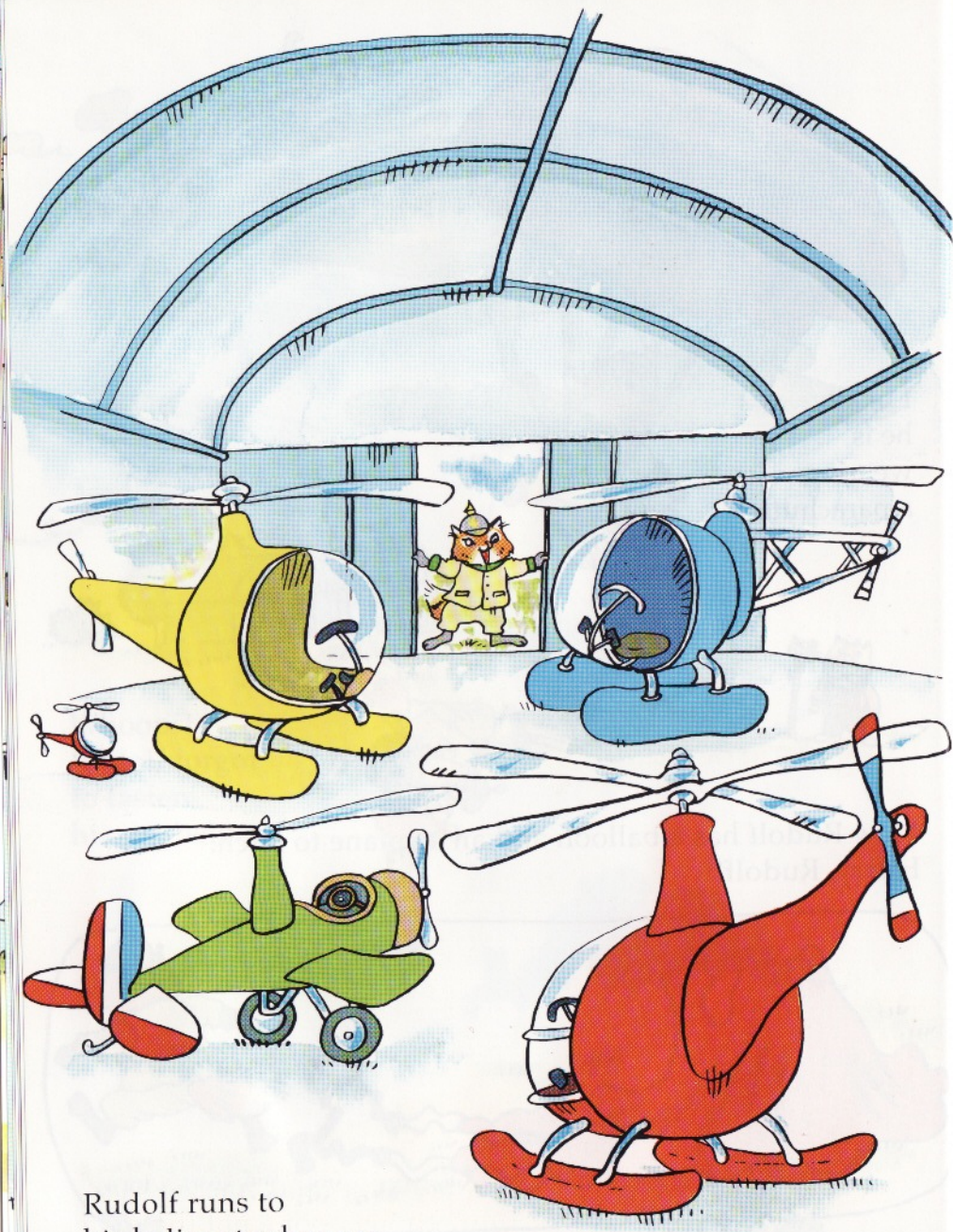


Luckily,

Rudolf runs to his helicopter hangar.

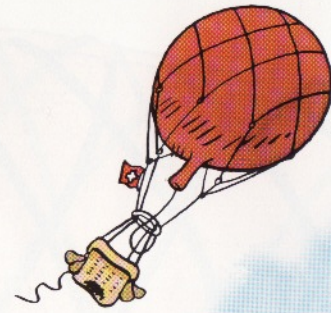
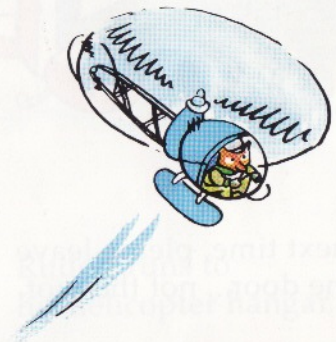


He chooses a helicopter and flies out.

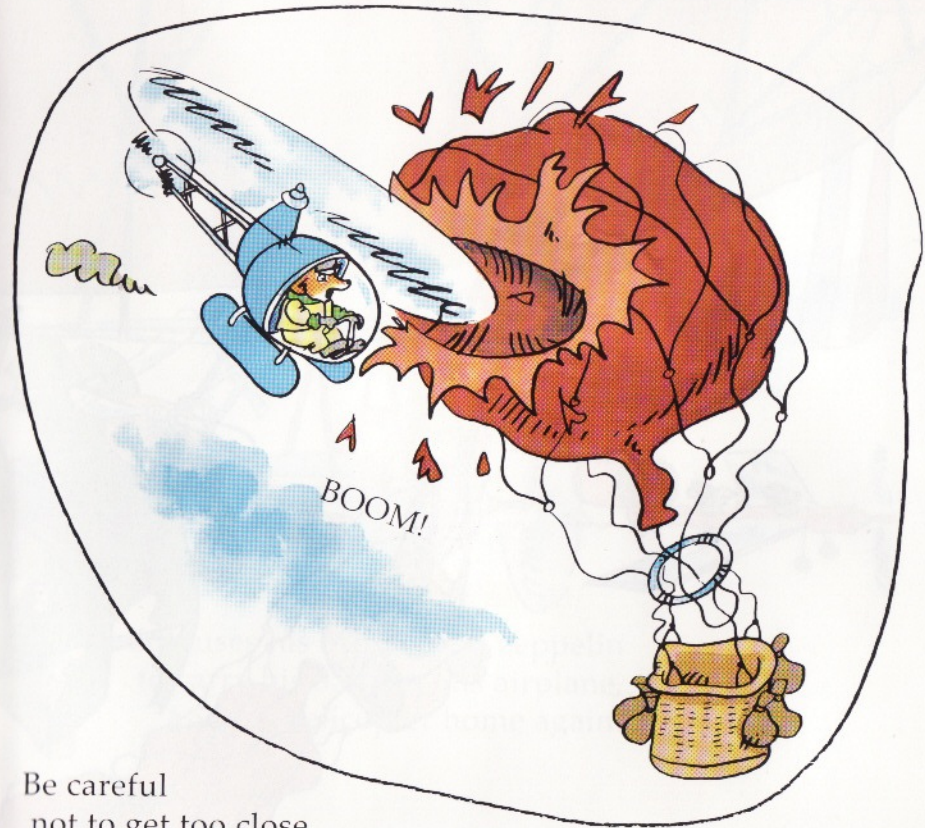
Please, Rudolf, next time, please leave through the door... not the roof.



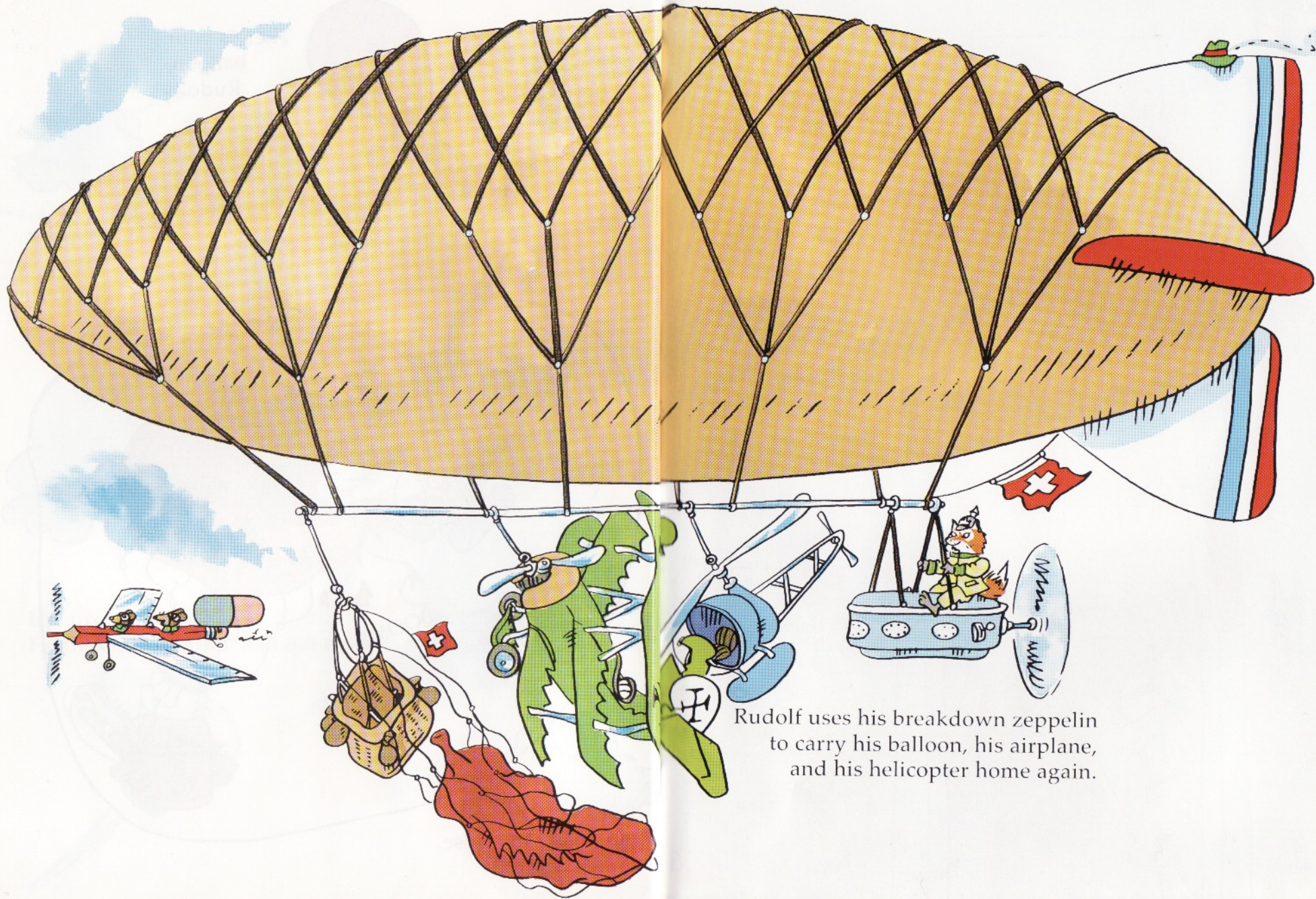
Up, up, up, Rudolf flies.
