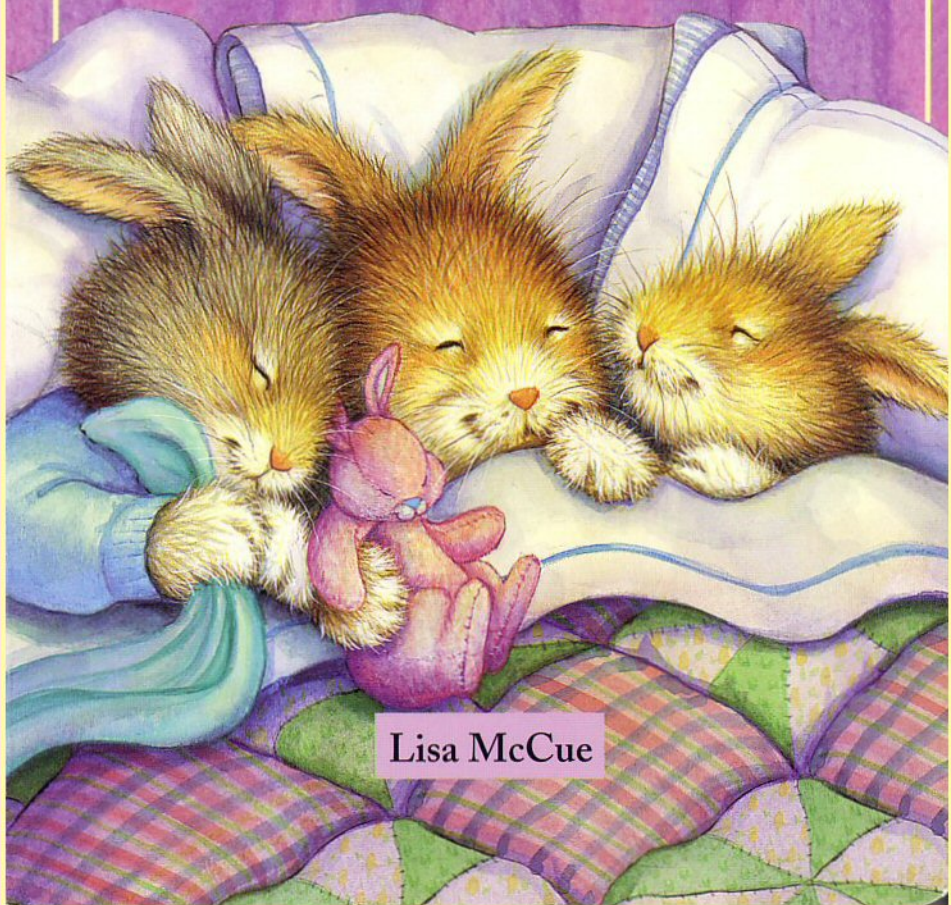


# Snuggle Bunnies



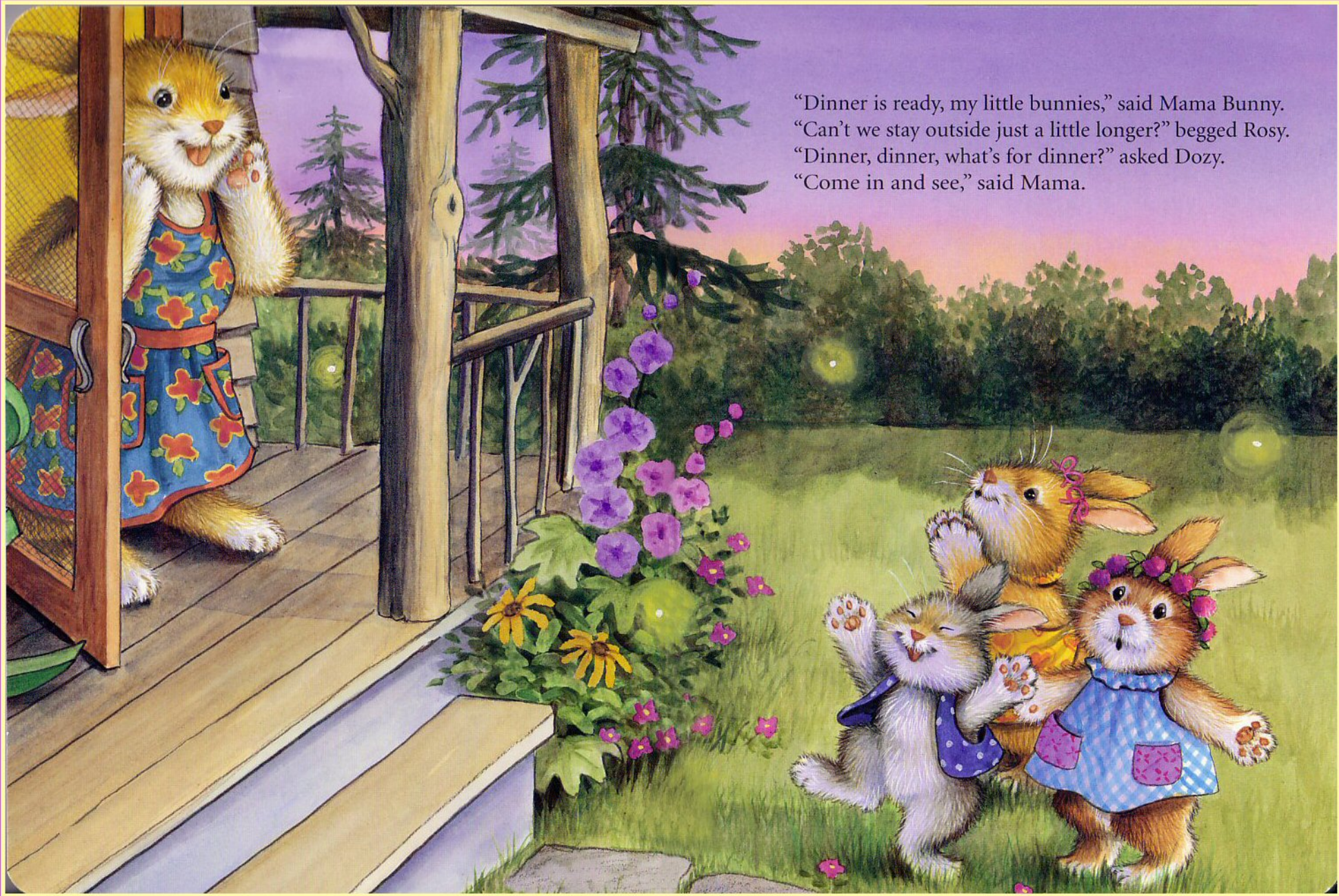
