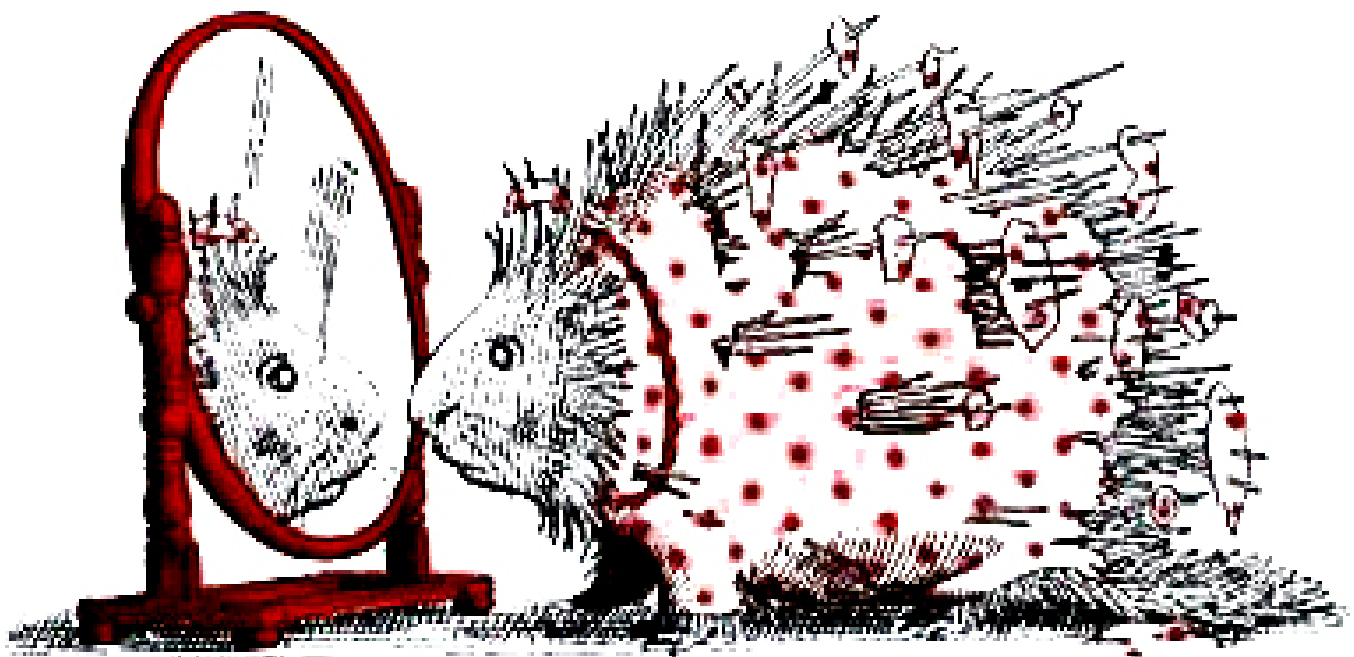

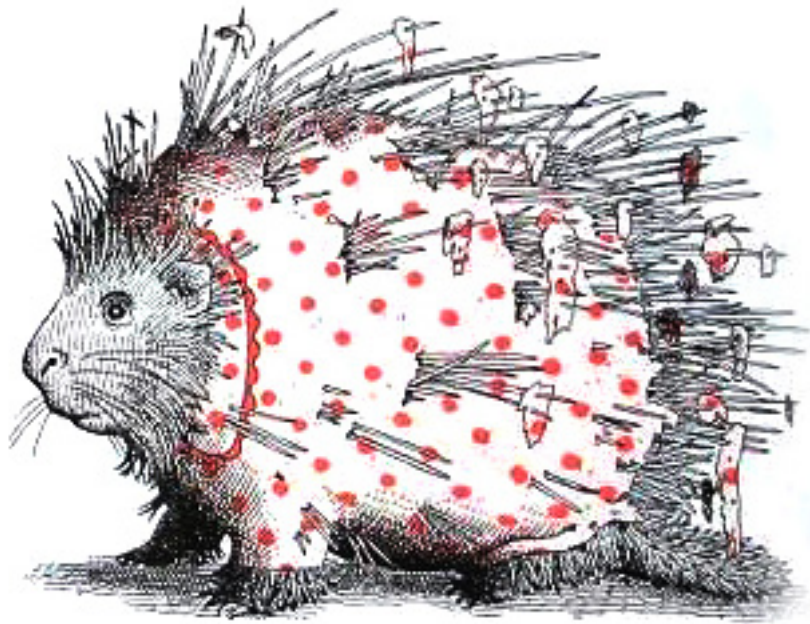

Animals should definitely not wear clothing...



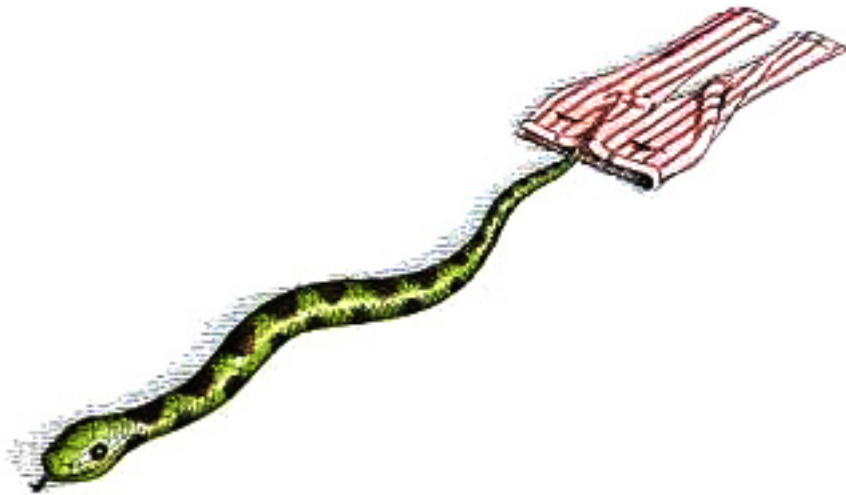

in the wrong places,**



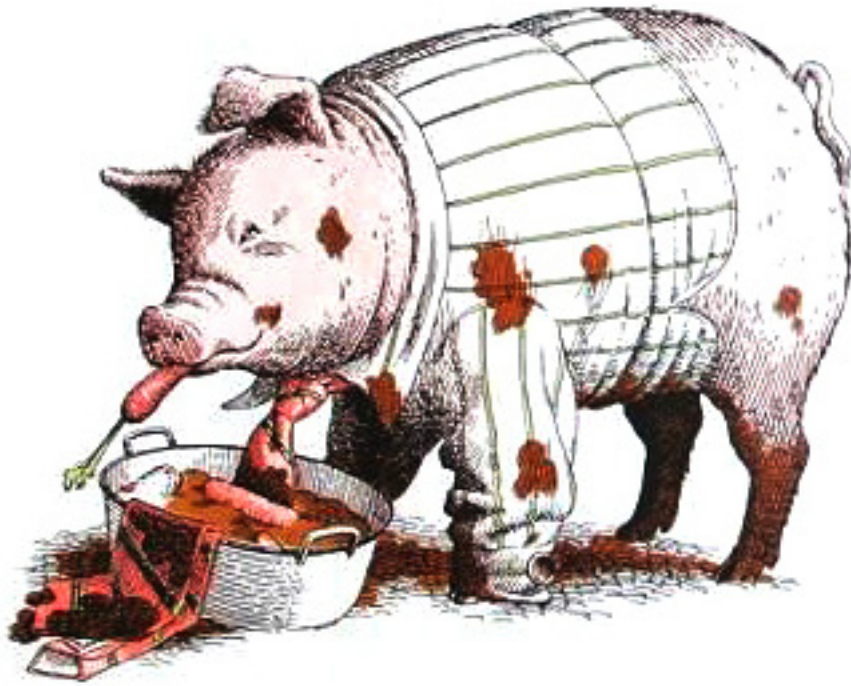
**Because a snake
would lose it,**



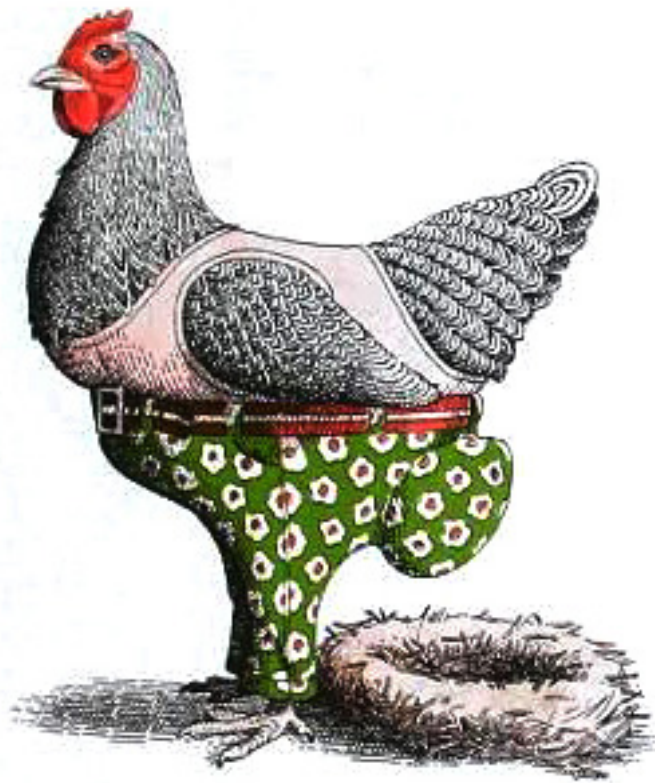
**Because a

sort of silly,**



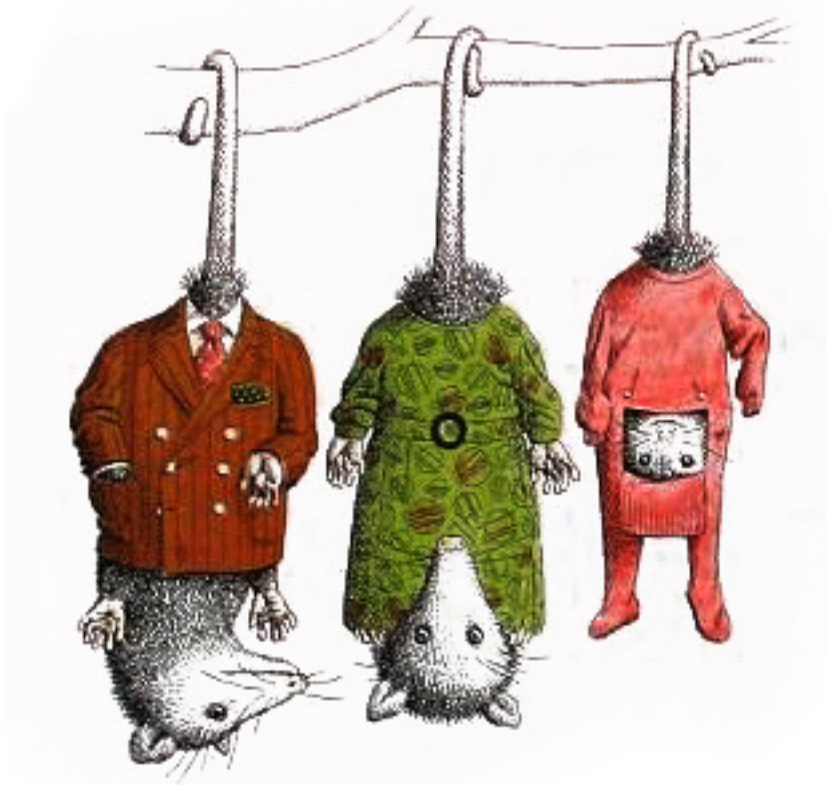
**Because a billy

for lunch,**



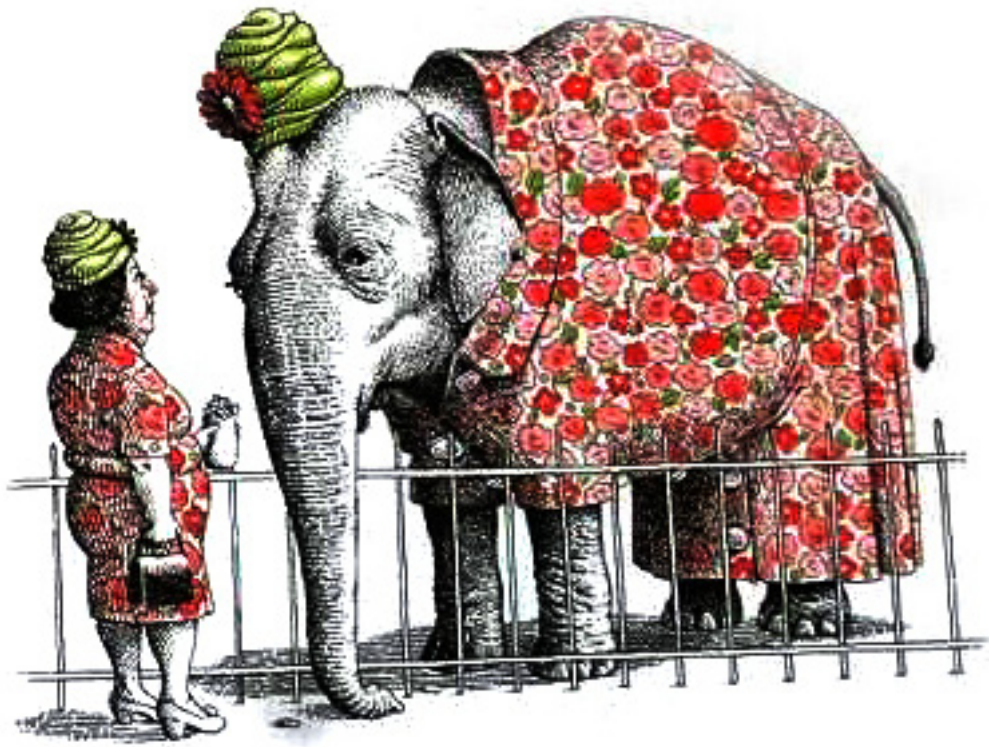
**Because it would

down by mistake,**



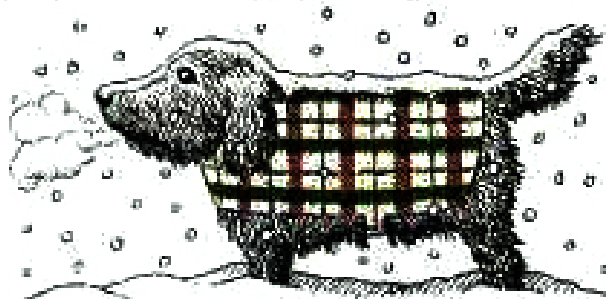
**And most of all,
